

Degrees of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite

The Degree Structure of the *Symbolic Degrees* consist of three degrees conferred in a Symbolic or "Blue" Lodge under the jurisdiction of a "regular" Grand Lodge of Masons.

The Degree Structure of the *Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite* is separated into five additional branches. These branches are the Ineffable, Historical, Philosophical, Traditional and Chivalric and the Official branches (each referred to as "houses").
